- Download the Assessor Evidence from the portal described in your Notice of Hearing.

Joining the Video Conference

- Log in no more than 5 minutes prior to your hearing's scheduled start time.
- Make sure your camera and microphone are on and your full name is showing.
- The Board will have reviewed the evidence before the hearing starts.
- The Clerk will admit you to the hearing when it begins.

Participating in the Hearing

- The chairman will let you know when it is your time to talk about your evidence.
- There may be questions about your evidence after you have finished.
- You may ask questions about the Assessor's evidence.
- The entire hearing is scheduled for 15 minutes.

The Board's Decision

- After evidence is presented, the Board will deliberate and make a preliminary decision.
- The final decision will be issued after all hearings for the 2021 year have been completed.
